Welcome to our 2022 TIGER BAY OPEN MEET.

In order to try and run a safe meet for all participants please follow these protocols detailed below. Welsh Govt. have announced remaining covid restrictions will end on 28 March. Co Cardiff & Legacy Leisure have undertaken the risk assessment for the meet. We ask all participants/spectators follow these guidelines.

- Swimmers access the competition pool via the main reception and proceed via the 1st floor balcony
- Swimmers to arrive beach ready, follow the one-way system as directed and remain within the competition pool environment.
- Please leave plenty of time to arrive before each session.
- Visiting Clubs are requested to organise their teams and if possible, enter the building as a club.
- Swimmers are required to have their lateral flow test results ready on mobile phones (or printed email).
- Swimmers can leave via the changing village and parents can wait/collect their child(ren) in the reception area. There will be group changing facilities available if required.
- Coaches Officials Volunteers Parent helpers/chaperones are also to check in each day with their LFT
 and will receive a wristband to be worn whilst inside the competition pool. <u>Access is only via the fire
 exit opposite the CIP car park</u>.
- Spectators can access the competition pool via the fire escape on the ice rink side of the building are required to have their lateral flow test results ready on mobile phones (or printed email).

EVENT PROTOCOLS:

This applies - each day - for <u>all</u> participants; swimmers coaches officials Co Cardiff meet volunteers and spectators as detailed covering:


Lateral Flow Testing (LFT) protocols ALL ATTENDEES must adhere to the following LFT protocol:

- Attendees are required to self-administer a lateral flow test within <u>48 hours</u> before arrival these can be ordered from the NHS via: https://www.gov.uk/order-coronavirus-rapid-lateral-flow-tests
- Complete the LFT as per instructions, taking specific notice of the length of time required to leave the test before reading the results
- The result of the LFT must be reported to the NHS COVID reporting system This produces a text notifying of your negative result; https://www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result
- This text must be shown on the door at arrival, or print off email from NHS to show.
- This process must be completed by EVERYONE in attendance (regardless of age). Lack of evidence of a negative test will result in NO ENTRY to the venue.
- Non swimmers (coaches officials volunteers timing operator) will be given a wristband which must be worn each day.
- If your result is positive, you should not leave home and try to attend the gala.
- If you have any illness symptoms, do not enter the building and inform your club/coach.
- If you have come into contact with anyone with known coronavirus, do not attend the meet.

Whilst it is no longer a legal requirement to wear a mask indoors or socially distance, all participants may choose to wear a mask. We ask everyone to respect these wishing to remain socially distant.

Covid19 remains a health risk and with a large number of swimmers attending the gala over the weekend we encourage respect to those staying safe.

- Warm up duration is 20 minutes of which sprint lanes can open in the last 5 minutes.
- ❖ Girls to access the pool at the car park end of the pool; Boys via Ice Rink end.
- Coaches must ensure that their teams are supervised during warm up.
- Co Cardiff will provide up to 5 warm up Marshals to assist in the movement of swimmers.
- * Coaches and swimmers disregarding health and safety instructions, will be excluded from warm up.
- Dry side warm up may be limited. It is advised that clubs split their team into 2 groups and only allow swimmers to perform dry side before their actual warm up.

Please ensure your swimmers exit the pool at the side and do not climb out over the timing pads as this can cause damage to the pads and lead to delays to the meet.

Marshalling: Swimmers will be called to marshalling. It is the responsibility of the swimmer/coaches to ensure that they attend marshalling once called. Swimmers will then be directed to the standing areas (zones 1, & 2).

Officials: Officials can register at https://www.swim-meet.com/Availability/ to confirm their availability. Alternatively, we request that details of officials (together with their qualifications) are forwarded to our officials' co-ordinator Jim McCulloch: cardiffofficials@btinternet.com

Car Parking: Please use the Cardiff International Pool car parks.

Spectators: We welcome back spectators to watch the gala. Numbers are limited to 250 per day. Spectators are requested to comply with the event protocols and provide a negative LFT to gain entry.

The day ticket costs £7.50 for SAT & £7.50 for SUN. If parents are just attending s3 & s6 then a ticket for these sessions can be bought for £3.50.
