Spectator Information

The pool hall will open for spectator entry from 07:45 each day.

The front 4 rows are reserved for swimmers, coaches and club staff. We ask that spectators please occupy the seats from row five back.

Officials - All visiting clubs with 10 or more swimmers are requested to provide at least one qualified officials per session. Meals and refreshments will be provided.

Refreshments - The Café, which provides a catering facility serving refreshments for swimmers, spectators and coaches, will operate throughout this Meet. Refreshments may not be taken onto the poolside. There are also local facilities located near Cardiff International Pool.

Swim Shop - We welcome to the CIP balcony FINE DESIGNS and SWIMPATH.

Details of Event Parking

Directions to Cardiff International Pool together with a map showing of CIP are below




Directions to Cardiff International Pool

Cardiff International Pool, Olympian Drive, CF11 0JB Travelling from either west or east, take the M4 to Junction 33 Then take the A4232, towards Cardiff Bay. Take the 3rd main exit. (just after the elevated section) – A4055 to Penarth. Travel down the exit slip road, and at the roundabout then take the 3rd exit (towards Penarth),

and then take the first left at the traffic lights. At the next set of traffic lights turn right.

Marshalling - The pool layout is shown below:

Swimmers will be called to marshalling by the announcer. It is the responsibility of the swimmer and club coaches to ensure that they attend marshalling once called.



Warm Up & Session Times

Warm up sessions will be mixed. Coaches are asked to prioritise swimmers competing in the first heats of each session to warm up first and stagger their swimmers. We suggest swimmers aged 11/14yrs warm up at the beginning followed by the older swimmers in each club.

Even numbered lanes are to be swam in clockwise direction & odd numbered lanes swam anti-clockwise.

Lanes 1-8 are for warm up with a max of 16 swimmers/lane – as required by Legacy Leisure.

Lanes 0 & 9 are permanent sprint lanes – swimmers must swim to the 25m mark & exit the pool at that point. Further sprint lanes will be opened toward the end of each warm up.

There is NO warm down pool available. Warm up will end 5/10 minutes before the start of each session.

Boys are to access/exit pool from the ice rink end and Girls access/exit from the car park end

Please ensure your swimmers exit the pool at the side and do not climb out over the timing pads as this can cause damage to the timing pads and lead to delays to the meet.
