### **CONDITIONS**

To be held at Hengrove Leisure Park, The Boulevard, Hengrove Park, Bristol, United Kingdom, BS14 0JZ

#### Licence Number SW230895

- The meet will be held under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing and has been Licensed Level 3 by Swim England for entry into District Competitions.
- Entries must be received by midnight on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> June 2023. The promoter reserves the right to close early should the event become oversubscribed.
- All swimmers must be members of a club affiliated to Swim England, Swim Wales, or Scottish Swimming.
- All swimmers must be registered with the Swim England, Swim Wales or Scottish Swimming at Category 2 and should be able to substantiate this should they be required.
- The promoter reserves the right to accept or reject entries and also restrict entries in order to complete the meet within the time available. If the meet is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a **first come first served** basis.
- All entry times are NO FASTER THAN TIMES
- As soon as possible after the closing date, confirmed entries will be emailed to clubs, together with any information in respect of entries not accepted. All refunds will be made 'en block' to the club submitting the entries, these will be processed electronically on provision of club bank account details.
- The age groups are: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17and over ages as at 16<sup>th</sup> July 2023
- There will be medals in every event for the first three overall swimmers in each age group. Any disqualified swimmer will not receive awards.
- The pool is 50m and at a depth of 2m throughout. The meet will be swum Long Course. Anti-wave devices will be in place and electronic timing/placing will be used.
- Entry fees are £8.50 per event and include the levy per accepted entry made by Swim England for licensed events. Coach/team manager passes (maximum of 4 per club) are £15 each and entitle the holder to admission to all sessions, a programme plus a full set of results per club. Poolside passes will be issued only for people affiliated with the entering club and it is the responsibility of the participating club to ensure their poolside staff have up to date DBS clearances.
- Entry times shall be those for 50m pool times, converted if necessary. All times submitted must be truthful and
  correct as defined by the British Swimming Code of Conduct. It is the responsibility of all swimmers/parents
  and coaches to enter correct times as a random check will be done on the rankings database to check
  validity. Entry times should be Long Course times. Short Course conversions to long course made using
  British Swimming Tables will be accepted.
- City of Bristol Aquatics will not amend entry times for swimmers which have been achieved after entry has been received by the meet promoter.
- Entries and results for this meet will be held on computer. As required by the Data Protection Act 2018 submission of entries implies consent to the holding of personal information on computer. These details may be made public before, during or after the meet.

- Swimmers with a para swim classification must indicate this on their entry form. Swimmers with a Certificate
  of Swimming Disability must present that certificate to the Referee before the event(s) in which they wish to
  swim. Failure to do this may result in disqualification from the event.
- Payment is due as soon as entries are confirmed. (Please do not send payment until confirmed entry notification) Payment for entries must be received prior the commencement of the meet.
- Should payment not be received by City of Bristol SC prior to the commencement of the event the promoter reserves the right to remove entered swimmers from the event and exclude them from the results.

No refunds for entries will be given after the entries have been processed and accepted, except in the case of:

The production of a Doctor's or medical certificate confirming the athlete is unfit to compete.

Refunds in theses circumstances will be process post meet once the appropriate certification has been received by the meet promoter. It is the responsibility of the entrant to then provide a summary of events entered by the withdrawing athlete along with a bank account name, Account number and sort code into which the refund is to be made.

- Video and Photography: Following updated guidance from British Swimming the use of all photographic equipment is no longer controlled. Spectators / coaches and swimmers are reminded that if such equipment is used they should STOP AND THINK the guidelines on consent & decency must always apply. Photography guidance applies to all images and recordings taken on any camera, mobile phone or other recording devices. Social media guidance will apply if those images or recordings are being shared through any social media platform [all club welfare officers have a copy of Wavepower where full guidelines can be found]. You are reminded that FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY should not be used at the start of any race.
- The meet will be run without cards. Heats will be pre-seeded. There is no requirement for sign in
- Secondary Strobe light will be available for operation at this meet. Any swimmer requiring the secondary strobe should inform the promoter.
- Swimmers must report to the competitors' stewards' eight heats prior to their own.
- Wet swimmers are not allowed in the spectator areas.
- All events are HDW.
- Neither the promoter nor Parkwood Community Leisure accept any liability for any loss or damage to personal belongings.
- Should it be necessary to cancel the meet, for reasons beyond the control of the promoter, refunds will not apply once the meet has commenced. Prior to commencement refunds may apply at the promoter's discretion.
- In extenuating circumstances and due to situations out of the club's control during the competition the Lead referee in conjunction with the promoter reserves the right to make changes to the running of the meet.
- Any swimmer breaking these conditions will be liable to disqualification from any or all events.
- The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator. (example abusive or unacceptable behaviour)
- Over the top starts may be used at the promoter's discretion.

 Clubs are requested to supply a qualified Official for every 8 swimmers entered into the competition. However, entries will not be refused from clubs who are unable to supply qualified Official's. Officials can sign up via the link.

#### **COVID Safe Rules**

- All non-competing participants over the age of 16 should check in to the facility via the NHS Track and Trace QR code provided.
